### **Supply List for Secondary Art Classes**

Students taking classes in Art at Bremond ISD will need the following materials for the 2016-17 School Year.

#### **Middle School Art Classes**

(6) **Pocket Folders:** Folders should be paper only, no plastic or slick covers.

Students will use and decorate one folder per six weeks for class handouts, weekly tests, and as a study guide.

Art Folders count as a major test grade for the Six Weeks grading period.

(2) **Sketchbooks:** 9" X 11" sketchbooks with a spiral spine

Students will use sketchbooks for daily warm-up drawing exercises and practice of art techniques. Sketchbook work counts as part of the daily grade in art class.

#### **High School Art Classes**

(2) 2" white notebook binders with plastic cover inserts and two sets of 8 tab notebook dividers.

Students will maintain an Art Portfolio binder each semester of class handouts, weekly tests, and for use as a study guide.

Art Portfolios count as a major test grade for each Six Weeks grading period.

**(2) Sketchbooks:** 9" X 11" sketchbooks with a spiral spine are required.

Students will use sketchbooks for daily warm-up drawing exercises and practice of art techniques. Sketchbook work counts as part of the daily grade in art class.

**(1) 16 GB Flash Drive:**

High School Students will need to bring a flash drive with a minimum of 16 GB of storage space. This is in addition to other supplies and is not covered by the Art Supply fee. Flash Drives will be used to store "Photo Phriday" homework assignments which count as a Weekly Grade.

**(2) Packets of #2 HB Pencils:**

All Art Students need to bring this item.

Students will be using a large number of pencils in Art Class for drawing exercises and projects.

If you would prefer to pay a one time Art Class fee of \$20 to cover the cost of the required art supplies that option is offered. Please make checks out to the Bremond Art Club and **remember to write the students name on all supplies.**
