

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The Falls County Farm Bureau is pleased to announce our 2024 senior scholarships. There are three \$1,000 scholarships offered. In addition to completing this application form, applicants will be required to submit an unofficial school transcript, 300-word essay, letter from their high school principal indicating scholastic rank among classmates, and two copies of the completed application form.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Eligibility is limited to applicants who meet the following criteria:

- Applicants are 2024 graduating seniors.
- Applicants are children of parents who have been a member of Falls County Farm Bureau for one year prior to 3/18/24.

<u>The Application and Attachments:</u> Please provide detailed answers to the application questions and submit all required attachments. All information received from applicants will be maintained in confidence.

Required material for complete application:

- The completed application forms.
- A letter from the high school principal indicating scholastic rank among classmates (top 10%, 25%, 50% etc.).
- Unofficial school transcript
- A typed original essay, 300 words or more, addressing one of the following topics:
 - 1. My career goals and how I plan to achieve them.
 - 2. Why agriculture is important to me and to my family.

<u>Deadline:</u> The Deadline for the completed application and all required materials to be received by the Falls County Farm Bureau office is <u>5pm on March 18, 2024.</u>

<u>Delivery:</u> Applications can be sent via hand delivery or mailed to either the Marlin or Rosebud office at the addresses listed below.
