In memory of Eric Wallace, on the 30th anniversary of his high school graduation, the Bremond High School class of 1994 would like to offer a scholarship to Bremond High School graduating Senior(s). Eric was a member of the BHS Class of 1994, who went on to become a Bryan Fire Department Lieutenant. Tragically, he lost his life in the line of duty on February 15, 2013 while fighting a three-alarm fire.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a graduating senior of the BHS class of 2024
- Must have proof of acceptance to a trade school, college or university
- Applications must be returned to Lynn Drews **on or before April 12, 2024**

Criteria for Awards:

- Participation in extra-curricular activities and/or community service
- Evidence of work experience, leadership, maturity, and character
- Proof of satisfactory (passing) grades

Application Requirements:

Each application must contain the following information, and if hand-written, must be legible. If your application is not legible and written with proper grammar and punctuation, it will be disqualified. Please DO NOT use TEXT SHORTHAND. Questions must be answered in complete sentences.

1. High School Transcript
2. Activities - attach a list of organizations, extracurricular activities, and/or community service projects you have participated in during your high school career, and any applicable positions held in each.
3. References - include two (2) character reference letters from NON-RELATIVES (this can include teachers, supervisors, pastors, etc.)
4. Essay - write a short essay (less than 500 words) explaining the following:
 - What career choice are you pursuing and why?
 - Where do you plan to continue your education to pursue your career choice?
 - Who has influenced your career decision most and why?
 - Where do you see yourself in the next 5 years?
